IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Standing Order 15, governing attorney admission fees, is
WITHDRAWN.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective June 1, 2004 the fee for admission to practice
in the United States District Court for the District of Montana shall be \$250.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that from these fees of \$250.00, the Clerk shall make the
following deposits:

- 1) twenty dollars (\$20.00) shall be deposited into the General Fund (085000),
- 2) one hundred and thirty dollars (\$130.00) shall be deposited into the Special Fund for
the Judiciary (510000), and
- 3) one hundred dollars (\$100.00) shall be into the District of Montana Non-Appropriated
Fund (6855XX).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective June 1, 2004 the fee for admission *pro hac
vice* to practice in the United States District Court for the District of Montana shall be \$250.00.
The entirety of the *pro hac vice* fees shall be deposited by the Clerk into the District of Montana
Non-Appropriated Fund (6855XX).

The Clerk of Court is directed to notify the judicial officers, deputies-in-charge of the divisional offices, and Financial Division of this District of the making of this Order.
