Motions to Vacate, Set Aside, Amend or Correct filed under 28 U.S.C.§ 2255

Motions to Vacate, Set Aside, Amend or Correct filed under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 may be filed electronically by counsel. Use the event 2255 (Motion to Vacate).

A word of caution, however. Before e-filing the 2255 motion, you must obtain a civil case number from the clerk's office. At the very last page, after you have reached the point of no return, you will be prompted for the civil case number. Enter the case number in the following format:

When you click next, the NEF will notify you that a civil case has been opened.
