IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Standing Order DWM - 45, issued
November 16, 2006, is WITHDRAWN.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to the reporting requirements of
28 U.S.C. § 994 (w)(1),

1. After sentencing in each case in which a pre-sentence report is waived or
otherwise not issued, the United States attorney shall, within 20 days of the date of
sentencing, send to the clerk of court a summary setting forth the sentence, the
offense or offenses for which it is imposed, the age, race, and sex of the offender,


and all adjustments and departures actually applied in fashioning the sentence.

The summary shall be sent to the clerk in electronic format as the clerk shall direct further.

2. The clerk shall assemble the documents specified in 28 U.S.C. § 944 (w)(1) in electronic format and transmit same, along with the summary in Paragraph 1, above, to the United States Sentencing Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk shall provide a copy of this Order to all Montana district judges and magistrate judges, all divisional offices of the District of Montana, and the United States attorney for the District of Montana.
