STANDING ORDER No. DLC-33

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the United States Probation Office for the District of Montana may, at the discretion of the chief United States Probation Officer, enter into reciprocal working arrangements with Montana state and county probation and parole agencies allowing for the exchange of information contained in presentence investigation reports. Any such arrangements must require that information disclosed be used only for presentence investigation and the preparation of presentence reports, and that the receiving agencies maintain the essential confidentiality of the information exchanged. Disclosure of information relating to defendants not yet sentenced is prohibited, except where necessary to prevent harm to the defendant or others.
