In order to ensure that Speedy Trial Act (18 U.S.C. § 3161, et seq.) requirements are fully monitored and in order to assist the presiding judge of each division of the Court in scheduling matters within the parameters established by the Act,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The United States Attorney's Office will provide to the presiding judge of each division of the Court no later than 4:00 p.m. on the first Monday of each month a report of all untried criminal cases pending in that Division of the Court. The report will reflect for each case: (1) the case number; (2) the identity of each defendant; (3) the date of commencement of the speedy trial clock for each defendant; (4) number of days excluded from speedy trial calculation for each defendant as of the date of the


report; (5) the number of speedy trial calendar days remaining for each defendant as of the date of the report; and (6) the current trial date.

The Clerk of Court shall inform all judges and the office of the United States Attorney's Office in all Divisions of the District of the making of the Order.
