ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 23-14

On April 10, 2023, following House and Senate passage, President Biden signed into law a Joint Resolution (H.J. Res. 7), which provides that “the national emergency declared by the finding of the President on March 13, 2020, in Proclamation 9994 . . . is hereby terminated.” As a result, the authority to use video and teleconferencing technologies in certain criminal proceedings under § 15002(b) of the CARES Act expired May 10, 2023.

Accordingly, Administrative Order 23-08 In Re: Renewal of Authorizations and Findings Under the Cares Act is HEREBY WITHDRAWN.
