ELECTRONIC PUBLIC ACCESS FEES  
FOR PETER MATT

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 26-28

The Court hereby finds that Peter Matt (PACER #9081874) falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for exemption from the fees imposed by the Electronic Public Access fee schedule adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United States Courts. An exemption is necessary in order to avoid unreasonable burdens to Mr. Matt in his research. Accordingly, Peter Matt shall be exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this court, to the extent such use is incurred in the performance of his research. Mr. Matt shall not be exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this court.

Additionally, the following limitations apply:

1. this fee exemption applies only to Peter Matt and is valid only for the purposes stated above;
2. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this court that are available through the PACER system;

3. by accepting this exemption, Peter Matt agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
4. Mr. Matt is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistributing via internet-based databases; and
5. this exemption is valid May 27, 2026 through July 17, 2026.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the court at any time. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the PACER Service Center.
