STANDING ORDER No. BMM-15


In light of the implementation of the Next Generation of CM/ECF,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Local Rule 83.8 of the Local Rules of Procedure for the District of Montana, which allows self-represented to file via e-mail, is amended to allow self-represented litigants to file electronically by registering as a non-attorney filer through PACER. As of October 15, 2021, all filings by self-represented litigants must be done through CM/ECF, by mail, or by in person delivery to the clerk's office.

Except for submission of an initial complaint, self-represented litigants may no longer submit their filings via e-mail. A self-represented litigant may still consent to have documents filed in their case sent to them via e-mail except in attorney discipline and social security matters.

The clerk of court is directed to promptly notify all self-represented litigants currently filing by e-mail of the entry of this Order.
