STANDING ORDER No. BMM-10

To facilitate this Court's participation in the Judiciary's District Court Audio Streaming Pilot Program,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Local Rule 1.3(c) of the Local Rules of Procedure for the District of Montana, which prohibits broadcasting of court proceedings, is amended to allow district and magistrate judges to participate in the District Court Audio Streaming Pilot Program established by the Judicial Conference of the United States in March 2020 (JCUS-MAR 2020, p. 9). The pilot seeks to study issues associated with livestreaming audio of certain civil proceedings with the consent of the parties to the proceeding.

This exemption applies only to livestreaming of audio conducted pursuant to the pilot program guidelines issued by the Judicial Conference Committee on Court Administration and Case Management.

The clerk of court is directed to promptly notify the judges of this Court of

the entry of this order.
