STANDING ORDER DLC-27

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Standing Order RFC-12, governing attorney admission fees, is WITHDRAWN.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective December 1, 2016 the fee for admission to practice in the United States Courts for the District of Montana shall be \$255.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that from these fees of \$255.00, the Clerk shall make the following deposits:

- 1) twenty dollars (\$20.00) shall be deposited into the General Fund (085000),
- 2) one hundred and sixty-one (\$161.00) dollars shall be deposited into the Special Fund for the Judiciary (510000), and
- 3) seventy-four dollars (\$74.00) shall be deposited into the District of Montana Non-Appropriated Fund (6855XX).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that effective December 1, 2016 the fee for

admission pro hac vice to practice in the United States District Court for the District of Montana shall be \$255.00. The entirety of the pro hac vice fee shall be deposited by the Clerk of Court into the District of Montana Non-Appropriated Fund (6855XX).

The Clerk of Court is directed to notify the judicial officers of the District of the entry of this Order.
