STANDING ORDER No. BMM-24

Upon request of the Office of the Pardon Attorney of the Department of Justice, the United States Probation and Pretrial Services Office (“USPO”) for the District of Montana is authorized to disclose presentence investigation reports for defendants seeking executive clemency and/or pardon for federal offenses. Information disclosed pursuant to this order may be used only for the evaluation of pardon or clemency applications, and the Office of the Pardon Attorney shall otherwise maintain the essential confidentiality of presentence investigation reports.

Upon disclosure of any such reports, the USPO shall include a statement advising the Office of the Pardon Attorney of these confidentiality requirements.
