IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective October 1, 2024, the transcript rates for transcript orders made in the District of Montana are updated as follows:

	Original	First Copy to Each Party	Each Additional Copy to the Same Party
<b>30-Day Transcript (Ordinary)</b> A transcript to be delivered within 30 calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$4.40	\$1.10	\$0.75
<b>14-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within 14 calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$5.10	\$1.10	\$0.75
<b>7-Day Transcript (Expedited)</b> A transcript to be delivered within seven calendar days after receipt of an order.	\$5.85	\$1.10	\$0.75
<b>3-Day Transcript</b> A transcript to be delivered within three calendar days after receipt of order.	\$6.55	\$1.30	\$0.90
<b>Next-Day Transcript (Daily)</b> A transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday), prior to the normal opening hour of the clerk's office.	\$7.30	\$1.45	\$1.10
<b>2-Hour Transcript (Hourly)</b> A transcript of proceedings to be delivered within two (2) hours from receipt of the order.	\$8.70	\$1.45	\$1.10
<b>Realtime Transcript</b> A draft unedited transcript produced by a certified realtime reporter as a byproduct of realtime to be delivered electronically during proceedings or immediately following receipt of the order.	One feed, \$3.70/page Two-to-four feeds, \$2.55/page per feed Five or more feeds, \$1.80/page per feed **Orders placed on or before the day of the proceeding will be batched together for purposes of determining the number of feeds; and subsequent orders will be charged at the lowest page rate assessed on the previous orders.
