Character

• As evidenced by actions at the scene



Personal History

- Age
- Family
- Education/Intellectual Capacity
- Medical/Psychological Health



Nature of the Offense

- Characteristics of the Crime
- Intention
- Premeditation



Punishment

• Just Desserts



Rehabilitation

• Likelihood of Change



Just Sentence

- Proportionate to the Severity of the Crime
- Most Appropriate Option of the Available Alternatives



• Attempt to Remedy/Make Whole



Deterrence

• For the Individual and the Public



Public Safety
