
STANDING ORDER No. BMM-5

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4(e)(2)(C),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of Court for the United States District Court for the District of Montana, and any deputies thereof, is appointed to receive service of process on behalf of any judge or employee of the United States District Court or the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Montana. Such service upon the Clerk of Court shall be to the same effect as if it were served on the judge or employee personally, in any matter arising from or pertaining to the judge or employee's official duties or capacity as a judge or employee of the Court. This appointment shall remain in effect until such time as it may be terminated or replaced by a subsequent appointment.

The clerk shall immediately inform all divisional offices, the judicial officers of this district, and the United States Probation Office of the entry of this Standing Order.
